### **Important information regarding the 13<sup>th</sup> Biennial ACENDIO Conference**

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, the **abstract submission deadline is extended to September 15, 2020.**

The 13<sup>th</sup> Biennial ACENDIO Conference takes place at the Hanze University of Applied Sciences, Groningen, the Netherlands, from **18-20 March 2021.**

The Local Organizations (LOC) and the Scientific Conference Committee (SCC) are constantly surveilling the Covid-19 situation. Presenters and participants will be informed immediately should changes be needed, and further information updates are warranted.

We are hopeful that the Covid-19 situation will allow people to travel and gather on March 18-20, 2021, so that the conference can take place as planned. The current regulation in the Netherlands allows 100 participants in the conference main hall. As ACENDIO is known for meeting colleagues and sharing ideas, we recommend you an early registration to assure getting a seat.

Presenters have the priority to join the conference (participation list by date of registration). If the allowed number of persons changes, you will get information immediately.

**Should ACENDIO having to postpone the conference (e.g. from March 18-20 to fall 2021), all accepted abstracts and registrations will remain valid.**

**If ACENDIO cancels the conference, you will immediately get the full conference fee back.**

In the meantime, the LOC and SCC are exploring ideas to be ready, if travel or other restrictions would occur. In this case, part of the conference (e.g. webinars) and the General Assembly would be offered online at the planned March 2021 date.

The adapted conference schedule is outlined in the *last call for abstracts*.

A **conference app** with all conference material will be offered to you after your registration, and papers of presentations will later be published via conference app.
